Our strategic location in the Bering Sea is uniquely well-suited to serve as a jumping-off point for Arctic operations requiring maritime support. Available facilities include an ice-free, deep-draft port with breakwater and three piers, airport with 7,900-foot paved runway, hangars, medical clinic, fuel storage/tank farm, upland storage, wind-diesel hybrid power utility, a modern hotel located at the St. Paul Airport, Coast Guard, NOAA and NWS presence, space for growth and a supportive landowner. St. Paul Island Operations also manages maritime-support facilities at Chernofski Harbor on Unalaska Island.
